

TOWN OF WINHALL  
Solid Waste Hauling Ordinance

WHEREAS pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §2202(a) the Town of Winhall is responsible for the management and regulation of the storage and collection of solid wastes within the Town; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §2291(12) the Town is empowered to regulate the storage or dumping of garbage and to provide for the removal thereof; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §2291(4) the Town is empowered to regulate the operation and use of vehicles within the Town; and

WHEREAS the uncovered hauling of loose solid waste along Winhall Hollow Road and other town roads has created a nuisance and a threat to the public health, safety, welfare and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §1971 et seq. the Selectmen of the Town of Winhall, Vermont adopt the following ordinance for the regulation of hauling of solid waste within the Town of Winhall:

1. No person shall haul upon any public highway within the Town of Winhall in any vehicle, or part thereof or any means of conveyance attached thereto, solid waste which is not contained in closed receptacles or covered with a secure covering so that no part of the solid waste blows or falls from the vehicle.
2. Any violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of \$ 25<sup>00</sup> for each offense.
3. This ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days

from the date of its adoption or September 4<sup>th</sup>, 1982.
